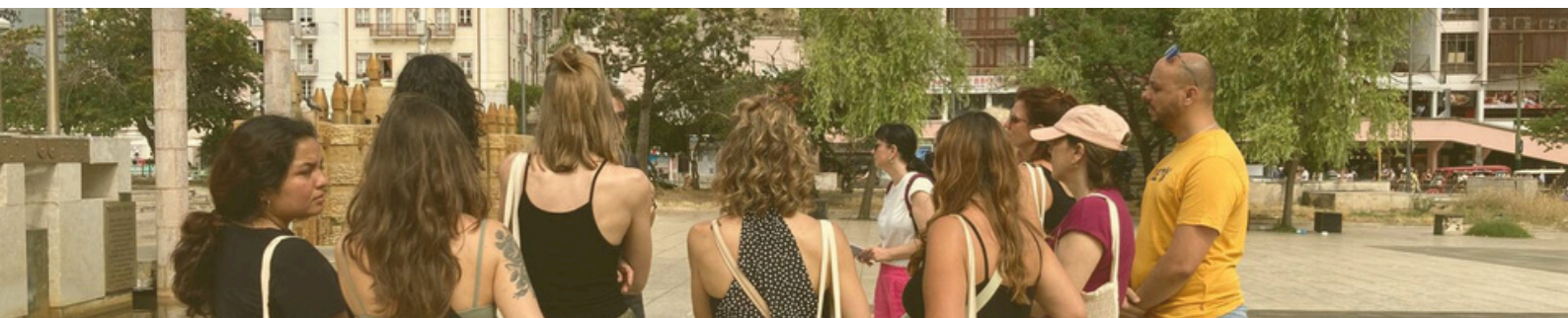

In this training, we will approach **Human Rights, Sustainable Development, Environmental and Health Education and Interculturality**, from the perspective of key concepts, but also activities and resources that can be used in the classroom to cultivate a learning environment that shapes future generations into conscious global citizens.

Teachers, educators, social workers, among other professionals of education, will develop their skill on promoting awareness-raising and mobilisation activities tailored to the learners, identifying appropriate and appealing teaching resources, and fostering the development of critical thinking in learners.

Intercultural Communication

In an Intercultural Lisbon, this course offers practical tools to improve communication with children, young people and adults from **diverse cultural backgrounds**. Through **active methods** such as role-play, group dynamics and intercultural field activities, the course develops key competences to **manage cultural and language barriers** and support the integration of migrant communities.
